- Manuscripts must be composed in MS Word format and typed double spaced with at least one-inch margin on all sides of A4 Size and to be sent through OJS at journal's official website.
- Manuscripts may preferably comprise 6000 to 7000 words. However, as per the importance of issue discussed in the article and its fine presentation, some relaxation may be acquired.
- Notes and references should follow The Chicago Manual of Style 17th Edition (End Notes only) i.e. to be marked serially and placed at the end of the manuscript.
- Authors are requested to quote the English translation of the Holy Qur'anic verses from the editions of only Mufti Muhammad Taqi Usmani.
- Authors are requested to provide their C.V. mentioning their designation, permanent and present postal addresses along with their cell/WhatsApp numbers and e-mail addresses.
- All correspondence regarding the manuscript will be directed to the corresponding author.
- After publishing the article, 2 complimentary copies of the relevant issues of the *Hamdard Islamicus* will be sent to the author.
- Ensure the submission is as requested by the journal and contains all relevant sections. See Authors' Guideline available on journal's official website.
- Non native English speakers are encouraged to have their manuscript professionally edited before submission. This is particular key for resubmission.
